# **Supplier Code of Conduct**

## 1. Commitment to Sustainability and Ethical Business Practices

D&R Dispersions and Resins Sp. z o.o. is committed to conducting its business responsibly, adhering to environmental, social, and governance (ESG) principles. D&R expects its suppliers to support these commitments by following this Code of Conduct, which outlines our standards for sustainable and ethical practices.
